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Conditions for Legal Abortion

Gestational limit: Procedure must be performed within 120 days (approximately 17 weeks) of pregnancy.

Licensed facilities: Only authorized medical institutions can perform abortions.

Specialist involvement: Procedure must be conducted by a qualified obstetrician-gynecologist.

Committee approval: A committee comprising a gynecologist, psychiatrist, and legal representative must approve the procedure.

Residency requirement: Non-citizen women must have resided in the UAE for at least one year.

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Dangers of Unauthorized Abortion Services

Health Risks

Engaging with unlicensed providers or purchasing abortion pills through unauthorized channels poses significant health risks:

Incorrect dosage: Leads to complications or ineffective termination.

Lack of medical supervision: No professional guidance increases risk of adverse effects.
